Information from Amish Mennonite Genealogies, page 407, by Hugh F. Gingerich and Rachel W. Kreider. Footnote 10 "HSF [HISTORY OF THE SAYLER FAMILY] says that Daniel Seiler and brother Jacob came to America ca 1725-1730 with Dunkard migration - to LP [Lancaster County Pennsylvania] first then Daniel to FM [Frederick County Maryland] in 1772.

He may have came to America, December 22, 1744, on the ship MUSCLIFFE GALLEY, George Durell, Commander, from Rotterdam. List 109-C at the Courthouse at Philadelphia. Source : Pennsylvania German Pioneers, page 358 & 359.

James Lanning Saylor does not list the above ship in his HISTORY OF THE SAYLER FAMILY (pages 134-135). The following from page 142 is of interest to all :

Daniel Saylor (I), when he came to America, spelled his name S-e-i-l-e-r. Among his descendants there have been two modifications of that mode of spelling --- S-a-y-l-e-r and S-a-y-l-o-r. The greater portion of the family adopting the first modification (S-a-y-l-e-r), the author has used that method of spelling throughout the work.

The Sayers of Europe commonly spell their names as Daniel Sayler, the progenitor of the American branch of our family did --- S-e-i-l-e-r.

Among the memoranda and papers that came to the author from his grandfather, Dr. Christian Sayler (4-12), of Winchester, Ohio, was a letter from the distinguished minister, Daniel P. Sayler (4-46), of Double Pipe Creek, Maryland.

In this letter, relative to the spelling of the family name, Elder D. P. Sayler says: "The German e is the English a, and

the German i has the sound of the English y; hence the Americanized name is spelled Saylor, and all who employ the o are in error. The termination is ler, and not lor."

Will of Daniel Saylor of Fredrick County MD. Died 1778 [From James Lanning Saylor's Book, pages 14 – 16, transcribed by Paul Lee Saylor and edited by Stewart R. Saylor]

I in God's name, Amen, the 23rd of January 1773. I Daniel Seiler, residing in Fredrick Courts, in the Province of Maryland - I having been prior to this time in poor health; but have nerveless retained my sound mind and memory, but however as God has brought to my knowledge the fact that I must die I am willing to signify my last Will and Testament in writing.

Firstly; I commend my soul to God who gave it being. My body, when my time has come and passed, I ordain shall be placed in the earth; not doubting that I shall re-occupy the same when the day of Judgment shall come and the righteous shall arise. Now what concerns my present belongings with which God has blessed me during this life, I order and dispose of them as follows;

Prologue; to begin this is my Will and Testament that all my rightful debts be correctly paid. Item; so it know particularly at this point and place, that my land in Lebanon Township whereon I did live formerly was sold very cheaply to my two eldest sons John Sailer and Christian Seiler under these conditions and in no other sense that shall be firmly and indisputable kept and cannot be recalled that my two eldest, aforementioned sons have by such bargain at which I gave them such the land aforesaid been completely satisfied as to their portion, and that thereby I gave them their total and complete patrimony and that they have no father rights and shall have no farther claim on chattels I shall have hereafter; but they may fall to my other heirs; and if they or one of them shall not be satisfied then the executors of my estate shall pay him or them an English shilling in full of their dues.

Item; that the land whereon I now live in Maryland in Fredrick Courts, that shall my son Daniel Seiler have, with this condition, that he shall pay to my remaining three daughters full one hundred pounds as follows; To my eldest daughter Catherine Seillerin *{the in denotes female} three and thirty pounds and six shillings, eight pence; and to my second daughter Anna Seillerin, also three and thirty pounds, six shillings, and eight pence; and my youngest daughter Mary Seillerin as Bostian Neff's wife, them also three and thirty pounds, six shillings, and eight pence. Thereby it shall be provided that he Daniel Seiler pay the above money as follows:

Firstly: To his sister Catherine Seillerin shall he pay her money three years after both parties' death; and the next year thereafter he shall pay Anna Seillerin her above named share; and the third year to his youngest sister Mary her portion.

However, be it provided that should Daniel Seiler lose this land or that it should be taken from him, that he shall not be compelled to pay the aforementioned one hundred pounds.

Item; what now concerns my personal property or chattels it shall belong to my son Daniel Seiller, under the condition that he pay therefore to his mother twenty-five pounds as she may require the same, provided he shall also give her ten bushels of wheat and fifty pounds of pork and fifteen pounds of spun flax.

Item; it is also to be provided that she shall retain her widow's rights to live in the present house where she now lives, and shall also have a spot in the garden to plant, and that he, Daniel Seiler, shall, as long as his mother lives, keep a cow for her use in fodder, and also provide for the calf, also two sheep must he keep in fodder. Further it is to be provided that the bed and her chest together with what it may contain belongs to her and also that the sheet-iron room stove shall be hers together with the needful wood to burn in the same which he shall provide. It is further provided that his mother shall have the three Hackles.

To this my last will I nominate as administrations and executors Bostian Neff and Martin Gerger.

"To illustrate the movement from place to place, the Seiler family lived at various places in the region. Jacob Seiler was married in 1740 before coming to America in 1749. He settled in Somerset County, Pennsylvania, where a Bible record of his family is preserved. The first child, Ulrich, was born at Willsteig (Willenstein); the second Daniel, was born at Sembach north of Kaiserslautern in 1708; the third, Hedwig, and the fourth, Jacob, were born at Obermehlingen in 1711 and 1715. Gertrud and Johannes were born at 'Ischbach,' probably Waldfischbach, since the family was living there in 1738."

"Jacob Seiler's family in Pennsylvania spelled their name 'Saylor' and settled near Meyersdale."

"Another immigrant to Somerset County was Ulrich Gindlesberger, who lived near Kaiserslautern in 1738 and emigrated in 1749 on the same ship with Jacob Seiler."

"A resident of Mechttersheim who was a probable American immigrant was Abraham Kurtz, brother of Jacob, who came in 1749 on the Phoenix with Hannes Muller, Ulrich Gindlesberger, and Jacob Seiler. They all were likely from the Palatinate."

"Another neighbor [in Lebanon County, PA] of Jacob Nafzinger was Jacob Seiler, just across the river in South Annville Township. Seiler came on the ship with the Kurtz brothers, Hans and Stephen. He later moved to Bedford (now Somerset) County, to farm near Meyersdale. He spelled his name Saylor and became a large landowner and Mennonite preacher."

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"There is said to be a file of original grants at the Lebanon Historical Society, but I was able to find only one, that of Jacob Seiler in South Annville Township."

Jacob Seiler, sons of Joseph (Jacob) Seiler, came to America about 1750 and settled in Lancaster Co. Pa. Daniel was baptised at the Conestoga Church in 1752. In the spring of 1772 he moved his family to Frederick Co. Maryland and later many of his descendants moved to Ohio.

The name of Jacob Seiler appears on the ship list of the Ship Phoenix that arrived at the port of Philadelphia September 15, 1749. He settled first in Lebanon Co., Pa. Jacob and son John moved their families to Somerset Co. Pa. before 1772.

" Tradition has it that John born in 1740 was the first settled here in this county [Somerset] and that after the death of his mother, John brought his father here. One thing is certain, the wife of Jacob Seiler, who died Jan. 27, 1784 is not buried in the old family cemetary unless in an unmarked grave" - Dr. E.C. Saylor.

He was Amish then changed to Mennonite. He was ordained a Minister in Lancaster, Pa. In 1770 he moved to Somerset County, Pa. That part of Pa was not open to the white settlers previous to Nov. 5, 1768, on the signing of the Fort Stanwix Treaty with the Indians. Up to that time a severe penalty was attached to any whites attempting to settle in that section of the state and only the occasional hunter had learned of the fertility of the soil, and the promisedland. Evidently their reports had proven sufficiently alluring to the Saylor family to induce them to undergo the hazardous journey through the tangled forests. There were no roads and consequently no wagons, crude sleds and pack horses were the only means of conveyance.

He was the first Mennonite Minister in the Cassleman Valley.

He was NOT a gunsmith in Bedford boro as stated in some sources. That man was another Jacob - Jacob Saylor . The JS lock mark is attributed to him. He is beleived to be listed as a "Woods Ranger" in Pennsylvania service during the Revolution (# PA ARCH 23 at 277).

Our Jacob Seiler later lived near Meyersdale, now Summit Township, Somerset County: purchased land by Virginia patent near Ft. Pitt.

He is buried in the Saylor Hill Cemetery, Meyersdale, Pa.

She went to OH with her daughter Margaret Rebecca and son-in-law, George LONG c. 1845. She died in Coshhocton Co., OH 27 November 1848 and is buried in the Berger Shutt Cemetery in nearby bHolmes Co. OH. Her tombstone reads, "Magdalena, wife of Peter Keefer."

He bought it from Herman Long. He called it "SAYLORTOWN". A beautiful 2nd generation stone house (date stone 1783. I believe) is still there plus a 2nd house. Current (1997) owner was Robt. Copenhagen."

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The following will of Johannes Seyler, Sr. was transcribed by Paul Lee Saylor

Will of Johannes Seyler Sr.

In the name of God Amen, I John Seyler of Lebanon Township in the County of Lancaster and State of Pennsylvania being at weak in body but of perfect mind, memory and understanding thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind the mortality of my body. Do make and ordain, this my last Will and Testament in manner and from following- That is to say I recommend my soul into the hand of Almighty God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in decent Christian Burial, and as touching such worldly Estate where with it has pleased God to bless me in this life. I gave, devise and dispose of the same in the following manner and Form.

Imprimes it is my will and order that all my just debts and Funeral charges to be paid by my hereafter named Executors as soon as possible after my Decease.

Item: it is my will and order that my Plantation with all the appurtenances where I now live in Lebanon Township afore said containing One Hundred and fifty acres, my eldest beloved son John Seyler may have for the value of seven hundred and fifty pounds good hard gold or silver to be paid by my said son John Seyler in manner following to my hereafter named Executors or to the survivors of them after my Decease, that is to say as soon as he takes possession of my Said Plantation he my Said son John shall pay three hundred Pounds good hard money as aforesaid, and then yearly and every year upon the same date when he took possession Forty Pounds like money as afore, said till the whole is paid, but in case my said beloved Son John Seyler should not be willing to take the Said Plantation on the conditions aforesaid, then any one of my children may take said Plantation for the afore said conditions and payments, but if none of my children shall take my said Plantation for the said seven hundred and fifty Pounds good money as aforesaid, then it is my will and order that my hereafter named Executors hall sell my said Plantation at public vendue to highest bidder on Condition that the Buyer or Buyers shall pay three hundred Pounds like money as aforesaid on the same date when he bought the Plantation till the whole is paid.

Item: I give and bequeath unto my (twin) Beloved tow Daughters Eve Catherine and Catherine my own Bed and Tow cloth for two. Chaff Beds, also three Feather Pillows, two chests, Two Iron Pots, Two Pewter Barons and five Pounds good hard money gold or silver for Two Cows, my Executors shall equally divide the said articles between my afore-said two Daughters and likewise my Executors shall Buy for my said two Daughters two New Bedsteads and two spinning wheels after my Decease, but in case my said two Daughters should marry at or before my Decease then I will allow unto them Twenty four Pounds good New Feathers, but my above mentioned Bed shall come to the Estate again, further I give and bequeath unto my beloved Children viz. John Seyler, Peter, Jacob, Henry Seyler and Anna Barbara to each of them fifteen Pounds good hard money as aforesaid, the said money my Executors shall pay. Pay unto my said Children out of the first Payment due of the first Payment of my Plantation.

Item: it is further my will that all the Remainder of my Personal shall be sold be my hereafter named Executors at public vendue after my Decease, and then it is my will and order that all the Reminder of the money of my Real and personal estate shall be equally divided unto all my Eight beloved children by my hereafter named Executors or the survivors of them only allowing my eldest son John Seyler five Pounds good hard money as aforesaid over and above his equal share for his Birth Right.

Item: it is further my will that if any one of my Said Children shall take my Said Plantation on the above condition then the grain in the field shall be his and the two stoves and windmill must sell at the vendue further it is my will and order that my hereafter named Executors or the Survivor of them shall have full Power to give a good lawful Deed to the Possessor or Possessors for my said Plantation. And lastly I do hereby constitute name and ordain my beloved son John Seyler and my trusty Friend John Adam Heileman to be whole and sole Executors of this my last will and Testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow and revoke all former wills and Testaments Ratifying and confirming this no other to be my last Will and Testament. In Witness here of I have here unto set my hand and seal this second Day of March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand Seven hundred and Eight two.

Signed Sealed pronounced and Declared by the say John Saylor as his last Will and Testament in the presence of us.

Per A History of the SAYLER FAMILY by James Lanning Sayler, 1868:

About the year 1800 the widow and her children removed to Franklin county, Va. Between the years 1804 and 1809 the mother, with her four sons - Daniel, John, Martin and Christian - removed to Preble county, Ohio. Her daughter Catharine and Catharine's husband, Abraham Neff, also came. The family settled in the vicinity of the present village of Winchester in Preble county.

Notes for Daniel SAYLER

Per A History of the SAYLER FAMILY by James Lanning Sayler, 1868 :

Elder Daniel Sayler (2-8 from I) was born in Lancaster county, Pa., December 30, 1749. He died in Frederick county, Md, September 11, 1839. He, with his parents, were among the first brethren in what was afterwards so far and widely known among the members of the Brethren Church as the Beaver Dam Church. Daniel and his wife united early in life with this church and soon became prominent members of it. Daniel was early called to the ministry in it. He soon became known as an able exponent of the tenets of the church, and his services were in demand much of the time. He spoke in the German language, which was the language of his fathers, and which predominated at that time.

Daniel Sayler labored as a faithful missionary and as a servant of God in the church for a period of sixty years. He sometimes went as far south as the Blackwater district in Virginia, and as far east as Conestoga, Pa.

The marriage of Daniel Sayler occurred in the year 1772. His wife was Sarah Buechly. She remained, throughout their married life, a true helpmate in his Christian work. She was a kind mother, and endeared herself to all. She died in Frederick county, Md., in 1820. The two rest side by side in the family burying ground on the farm on which they lived, and which Daniel had inherited from his father. Their children were all born in Frederick county, Md.

The following extracts from the will of Johannes Seyler, Jr. transcribed by Paul Lee Saylor

The Last Will of Johannes Seyler Jr.

(3 pages abstracted) Made 3rd February 1784, probated when he died April 22nd 1786.

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This February 3rd 1784, I, John Seyler of Lebanon Township, Lancaster Co., Pa. Yeoman.... [preamble] make this my last will. First that all my debts and funeral expenses be paid as soon as convenient. Item, I empower my executors to sell and dispose of all my Plantation and land in the Co. Of Lancaster in Lebanon T. adjoining to land of John Reigh Peter--German Long Tobias Stiver and others, containing 300 acres, by private or public sale within one year after my decease for the best price can be gotten. Also to regulate how much the purchasers shall pay in hand, and yearly payments as they shall judge best. Item, - after my just debts are paid then what is remaining of my estate, one half shall be put out to interest for the use of my dearly beloved wife Franny as long as she remains my widow. If she requests it my executors shall purchase a small tract of land with one half of the money from my estate where she and the executors shall think proper. This shall be for the sole benefit of my wife during her life, unless she marries again. After her decease or remarriage, it shall go to my children share and share alike.

Item: -in case my Wife not remain my widow, my Wife shall have and receive one forth part of all the money from the sale of the other half. Item; -it is my will that my widow shall have the privilege to put my children among her friends until each child attains the age of 14 years.

Item: -it is my will that my executors shall put my sons to Trades as they shall choose, and cause them to be taught to read and write. Item:-my executors shall send my children under 14 years to school and pay the same out of my estate.

Item: -then all that remains of my estate not here-in before given to my wife I give and bequeath unto my six children, Maride, Daniel, Jacob, Christian, John, Henry, all the money arising out of my estate to be equally divided between them. If any die unmarried, without issue, that share shall be equally divided between the survivors.

Item:-I give unto my eldest son Daniel the sum of 5 pounds in hand, over his equal share with the rest. The yearly payments from my lands shall be paid to my said children as they succeed each other in age. I empower my executors settle and execute all and everything in my estate as they think proper. Lastly I do nominate, constitute and appoint my two brothers-in-law Jacob Light and Henry Light Executors of this my last Will and Testament, revoking any former wills.

Notes for Mary LIVENGOOD

The Peter Leibungutt Journal by Louis Ann Mast : Livengood Genealogy by Christine Reid lists Marie/Mary's death as December 30, 1830. However, this is the date of death on her husband's tombstone on Saylor Hill.

Dr. E. C. Saylor notes dated APR. 13, 1927 list death date of Mar 22, 1848. However, he does not list his source for this date.

March 22, 1848 is also the date of death of Elizabeth (Forney) Livengood wife of Christian Livengood LG1. This date from her tombstone in the Livengood Cemetery, Salisbury, Pa.

Mary Livengood is LG5 in AAMG. Elizabeth (Forney) Livengood would have been Mary's sister-in-law. Could they have died on the same date? Or is March 22, 1848 incorrect for Mary?

I'd have to look it up that she contracted helping a neighbor not long after the birth of a child of her own. David married again and moved to Liscomb, Marshall county, Iowa. I have much on descendants that I would share. Sarah's grave is now marked in Meyersdale with her husband's parents John and Susanna Bueghly, a sister and brother-in-law [Flickinger] and several young children. Their graves were moved from a farm cemetery.

WILL OF JOHN SAYLOR III

(John 3) Made November 3rd 1854

(This is an abstract of the 8 page will.)

Died during 1855

After the usual formal preamble, he wishes "to be buried beside my dear wife"; his desires and bequests are: 1. His gristmill and plantation on which the mill is situated lying on Sinking Creek--containing 159 acres--wants it sold to highest bidder. (One-fourth down and rest in equal installments; in 2 to 3 years, hold lean until all paid. Now occupied by son Isaac.) 2. I give and bequeath to my son Godfrey Saylor and daughter Sarah Saylor equally my home farm and saw mill lying on Sinking Creek containing about 135 acres. Sarah's part is for her sole use separate from her husband, should she marry. He say he values the property at \$1200. 3. Executors sell also the plantation upon which Godfrey Saylor now lives (commonly called the Ruble place, containing about 134 acres purchased by me from William Smith). 4. To Patsey Saylor, widow of son John Saylor, \$400.00 in trust to be equally divided between her and the children of John. 5. To my daughter Elizabeth Howard, wife of John Howard \$600.00 with full power to receive and dispose of as she may see proper--sole and apart from her husband. 6. Since he had made advancements to his three sons-in-law each of the three daughters shall receive \$600.00--minus what her husband owes to their father. Nancy--wife of George Gilly. Hannah--wife of Lemuel Bogart. Margaret--wife of William Odle (with no interest charged) (Notes are on file among his papers) 7. To son William Saylor \$600.00 minus money already loaned to him. 8. To son Henry \$100.00 as he had already been loaned \$500.00. 9. To son Abraham Saylor \$600.00 minus his outstanding notes. 10. To son Isaac Saylor \$600.00 minus note held for \$100.00. 11. & 12. To my grandchildren Godfrey Saylor and Sophronia Saylor Heirs of my son Joseph Saylor decd. \$600.00 (\$300.00 each). 13. To my daughter Sarah Saylor one of my horse beasts, she to have choice also one cow--her choice. I also give her as much of my household and kitchen furniture as she may esteem necessary for her comfort and happiness two brass (?) bedstead and bed clothing to be included. 14. To Sophronia Smith wife of William Smith, Sarah Gilly and Catherine Gilly all children my daughter Polly Gilly six hundred dollars--\$200.00 each. 15. Legacies to be pro-rated as money can be collected on farms. 16. That no injustice be done--no interest on any advancements made by him. All paid in bank notes. 17. Sell any other property not specifically bequeathed at public sale. 18. If any surplus over legacies and costs of administration then it must be equally divided among the Heirs except the heirs of son Joseph Saylor and Polly Gilly--son John's as he had already provided for them. 19. Revokes all previous wills. 20. I name and appoint my sons Henry and Abraham Executors--court not require security. Made 3RD day of November. 1854.

Now of Washington County, Tennessee had been married nearly 6 years and had at least 2 children when he came to Tennessee to settle. He probably bought his land and at least started his house before his wife came. He built a large two-story home, built of logs in T shape, with about 8 rooms with a chimney at each end. But no longer standing, it over the years was improved with weather-boarding and painted white. In 1813 he acquired 40 acres more, and at his death had 3 farms of around 428 acres, a grist-mill along Sinking Creek across from his home and a saw mill.

He must have been a very kind-hearted and generous man for besides the large loans to each of his sons and sons-in-law, mentioned in his will, many others owed his money. I knew of his old leather billfold and it was filled of small folded strips of paper, promissory notes from \$1.00 to \$100.00 signed by many neighbors and never paid off. Some date back to 1819. Some probably were made instead of payment for supplies from his mills. I was able to find the old desk that he had in the mill at St. John Mill with the date of 1811. The old graveyard where our ancestors were buried was not far from the

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old home. Most of the old slab markers are gone or overgrown with weeds and the writing illegible. It is still called the Saylor Cemetery. John III and his wife Betsy are buried there on Elizabethton Road.

In his deed in the Washington County Courthouse it tells in his deed that he was from Lebanon Township, Lancaster Co. Pa..

From the "History of Bedford and Somerset Counties Pennsylvania", by Blackburn, Welfley and Koontz, Volume II, pages 521-522:

"The first farms or tracts of land that were bought anywhere in Somerset county, west of the Allegheny mountains, solely as a matter of speculation or investment on account of the coal underlying them, were bought in 1853, and were in the Salisbury coal basin. The purchasers were J. Philip Roman and Norman Bruce, of Cumberland, Maryland. These

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farms are partly in Elk Lick and partly in Summit townships. They were purchased on options of six months, Jacob Brown, an attorney of Cumberland, securing them. The following are the farms as they were known in 1853: The Peter Saylor farm, 190 acres, consideration \$8,170...."

[See Somerset County deed recorded July 19, 1853 in Vol. 25 Page 602. Deed from Peter Saylor & Wife to Norman Bruce & Philip Roman. Containing 190.75 acres Consideration \$8,187. Signed with the marks of Peter Saylor and his wife Sally Saylor. Being the land transferred to Peter Saylor recorded in Somerset County Vol 17 Pages 582-582.]

"For purely agricultural purposes these farms rank among the best in Somerset county." "These farms were probably purchased on the assumption that the Pittsburgh & Connellsville railroad would be speedily constructed, when there would be little trouble in selling them at a large advance, but the construction of that road was distant almost twenty years in the future. Both Mr. Bruce and Mr. Roman died before the lands could be realized on."

In the book, A SAYLOR LINEAGE by John Galen Saylor is the text of the obituary "for Rudolph Saylor in the Meyersdale Republican, July 18, 1901" with the following information: "Jacob [SL413] was the father of six sons. Jacob, [SL4133] who first lived at Summit Mills, then moved to Milford Township near New Lexington, where he died; John, [SL4134] who lived and died in Milford Township, too; Peter, [SL4135] who owned the farm at the Shaw Mines and lies buried near the mouth of the mine; Samuel, [SL413a] who married a wife in Conemaugh Township, to which section of the county he moved and lived until his death a few years ago; David, [SL413b] the father of Rudolph, got possession of the home farm; and Christopher, who lived with David."

Peter's Cavalry Regiment is known to have participated in the Battle of Gettysburg and other engagements both before and after Gettysburg while he was in the service. Peter's Commanding Officer sent possessions and last words on to Mrs. Saylor after Peter died. Peter left 9 children (4 under the age of 10 in 1862). He died of Tuberculosis during the Civil War. He is buried in the Military Asylum Cemetery in Washington D.C. His grave can easily be found there according to a letter from Cyrus Saylor to Charles F. Cook found in the Saylor Folder - Somerset Historical Library. Peter's grave can be located in Washington, D.C. at the Soldier's Home National Cemetery, (Phone # 202-829-1829), 21 Harewood Road NW, Washington, D.C. in Section G grave number 4156. (Visited April 6, 1995 by Stewart R. Saylor) Sussannah Saylor's pension commenced 5 Nov 1863 at \$8 per month, later augmented by an additional \$2 per month for each child under 16 years of age as of 25 Jul 1862. Sussannah Saylor did not remarry by 1870 due to her Civil War Pension. The pension number was 92788 - per National Archives Trust Fund records and "Pensioners in Western Pennsylvania in 1883, Volume III, published by the Western Pennsylvania Genealogical Society, page 45 - spelling Saylon, Susanna." In the 1850 Census, Peter and Susan were listed in Greenville Twp., Somerset Co. PA with children George, Catharine and Conrad. In the 1860 Census, Peter and Susanna are listed in Brothersvalley Twp., Somerset Co., PA with children George, Catharine, Conrad, Elizabeth, Lydia, Samuel, Sarah and Andrew. In the 1870 Census Susan Saylor, age 45, lived with Solomon Burkhart, age 61, in Allegheny Twp., Somerset Co., PA. Before 1874 Susan's son, Samuel Saylor married the grand daughter of Solomon Burkhart, Susan J. Ferner, daughter of John Farner and Elizabeth (Burkhart) Farner. Samuel and Susan (Ferner) Saylor's three year old daughter, Minerva Saylor, died 15 APR 1878 and is buried in the Burkhart Burial Ground, Fairhope Twp., Somerset Co., Pa In the 1880 Census pages 221A and 221B, Susan Saylor is living in Allegheny Twp. with son Andrew, age 22, son Peter, age 19, and Andrew's wife Julia, age 17, and William Coughenour, age 7 - grandson. The exact relationship of William Coughenour is uncertain. In the 1990 Census, Fairhope Twp., Somerset Co., PA. BATTLE THAT SAVED THE UNION by Paul D. Walker, Pelican Publishing Company, Inc., 1000 Burmaster Street, Gretna, Louisiana 70053, 2002, pages 146-147 Thousands of battle deaths, and nearly twenty- two months of desperate fighting, remained before the results of the Battle of Gettysburg were finally confirmed. Col. William Brook-Rawle, a Union cavalry officer who took part in the action on the East Cavalry- Battlefield, offered, perhaps, the best synopsis of the battle and a fitting close to this book: "We cavalymen have always held that we saved the day at the most critical moment of the Battle of Gettysburg, the Greatest Battle and turning point of the War of the Rebellion. I know that it has not been the custom among historians to give us any credit for having done anything to affect the outcome of the battle. So fierce was the main engagement, of which the infantry bore the brunt, that the fighting on the part of the cavalry passed almost unnoticed; yet this was the only battle of the War in which the three arms of the service fought in combination and at the same time, each within supporting distance and within sight of the other and each in its proper sphere. The turmoil incident to an active campaign allowed us no opportunity to write up our achievements, and no news correspondents were allowed to sojourn with us to do it for us. But now that the official records of the campaign both Union and Confederate, have been brought together and for the first time, been made accessible and the official map of this field has been prepared, the great historian of the war as yet unknown, and perhaps unborn, will have at hand materials which have been denied to others. He will see the importance of the fight which I have attempted to describe, and will give it the credit due to it. Had Stuart succeeded in his well-laid plan, and with his large force of cavalry, struck the Army of the Potomac in the rear of its line of battle, simultaneously with Pickett's magnificent and furious assault in its front when our infantry had all it could do to hold on to the line at Cemetery Ridge, and but little more was needed to make the assault a success. The merest amateur in the art of

war can readily see what the result would have been. Fortunately for us; fortunately for the Army of the Potomac; fortunately for our country and the cause of human liberty, he failed. Thank God that he did fail and that with His Divine Assistance, the good fight fought here brought victory to our arms (Brook-Rawle, 228-29),"
